Shipping Instructions

January 1, 2012

Ensure all birds, fish, and mammals are frozen solid prior to shipping. Wrap in plastic bag prior to packing. Tape a rigid stick to outside of plastic wrapped fish. This helps ensure frozen fish is not broken in shipment. Migratory birds require special tagging and package marking requirements.

In a sturdy container, pack some kind of insulating material around the item such as styrofoam or crumpled newspaper.

Include mounting instructions and photos in a separate plastic bag along with item. Ensure all contact information for you is included...name, full address, cell number.

Ship on Monday via UPS so as to ensure no weekend layover spoilage.

All migratory birds must have a tag attached to each bird, signed by the hunter, stating his address, total number and species of birds, and the date birds were killed.

Mark outside of shipping container with name and address of shipper and consignee. Mark outside of container with species and number of birds.
